Notes to the Teacher

1. Send the parent letter (page 3) home with the student on the first Sunday of the quarter or deliver it personally before the quarter begins. On the back of the parent letter is an overview of this quarter's lessons and a list of all the memory verses.
2. Make sure absent students receive the student book sheet and the Strong Kids at Home take-home paper. The take-home paper has a summary of the Bible account you covered in class.

Using the Handwork Sheets

This book is perforated so you can tear out the sheets. Each page includes directions for completing the activities.

On the front of each student book page is an activity that reviews the previous lesson. As students arrive to class, let them work on the activity until you are ready to begin the class. Make sure the students' names are on their papers before you collect them.

You will use the student book sheets again at the end of the lesson to review the lesson they just learned. As they work on the activity, discuss the Bible story or its application. Any students who don't complete the page in class can finish it at home.

Thank you for bringing your child to Sunday School!

Exciting lessons await your child in this summer's Primary class. The class will learn about the church from the New Testament book of Acts. We will cover the coming of the Holy Spirit, the start of the first church, and exciting accounts of church leaders, including Peter, Stephen, Philip, and Paul. We will also study future events to discover the wonderful plans God has in store for believers.

Units 1 and 2 focus on serving God and others as part of Jesus' church. Your child will learn that the Holy Spirit helps believers do God's will and serve God well. Your child will also learn the importance of obeying Jesus' command to share the gospel with everyone.

Unit 3 covers future events, including the Rapture, Jesus' Second Coming, Jesus' Kingdom on earth, and Jesus' preparation of an eternal home for believers on a new earth. Jesus promised He would return one day. The lessons on future events will encourage your students to live in light of His return.

Talk with your child about the student book pages he or she brings home. Set aside time each week to help your child memorize the Bible memory verses listed on the back of this sheet. Your child will need to recite the current week's verse the following Sunday in class.

Encourage your child to read the Strong Kids at Home take-home paper and to complete the fun puzzles and activities. Read through the spiritual growth measurables to engage in your child's learning. Your child will learn a lot about serving this quarter, and we encourage you to find ways to let him or her serve God by serving others!

Quarter Overview

The Church Begins Weeks 1—5

Unit 1 begins with the events following Jesus' ascension into Heaven. Students will learn about the Holy Spirit's arrival and His work in believers' lives. As students study the apostles' ministries, they will learn that the believer's power to serve God comes from the Holy Spirit.

The Church Spreads Weeks 6—10

Unit 2 focuses on serving God and sharing the gospel. From the examples of the apostles and the early church, students will understand the importance of faithfully serving God and others with love. Students will also be encouraged to share the gospel in obedience to Jesus' command.

The Church with Jesus Weeks 11—13

Unit 3 covers future events, including the Rapture, Jesus' Second Coming, the millennial Kingdom, and living with Jesus forever in the believer's eternal home. Students will learn that God has promised an exciting and rewarding future for those who put their faith in Jesus for salvation.

Lesson 13

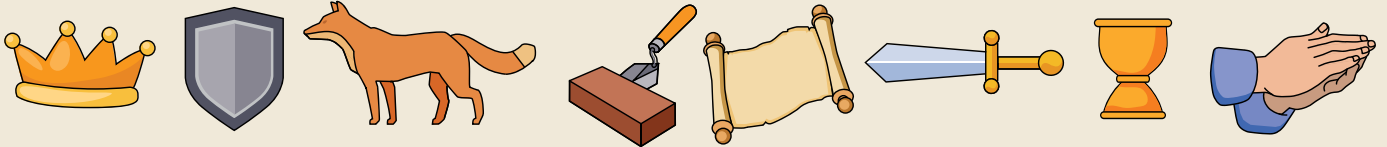
"Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people" (Revelation 21:3b).
