Notes to the Teacher

1. This book has been prepared for primary students. The book is perforated so you can tear out each sheet, complete it in class, and send it home with the student. Each page includes directions for completing the activities on that page.
2. Provide the memory verses for the quarter by giving your students a copy of the Memory Verse Booklet available from RBP.
3. The parent letter is on page 3. Send this page home with the student on the first Sunday of the quarter or deliver it personally before the quarter begins. Page 4 contains an overview of this quarter's lessons.
4. If a student is absent, make sure he or she receives a student book sheet and the Strong Kids take-home paper. This will help the student review the Bible lesson.

You will use the student book sheets at the end of the lesson. The students will work on the activities on the front and back of the sheets. As they work, discuss the Bible story or its application. Let students do as much as time permits, but if they cannot complete the activities in class, they can finish the activities at home.

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Welcome to our Primary Department!

The fall quarter study for primary students will help your child learn important truths about God and His plans. God intentionally designed the universe and everything in it. And even before God created the universe, He established His plan for salvation from sin. Unit 1 of this quarter focuses on God's plan for creation and unit 2 teaches your child about the beginning of God's plan for salvation.

Studying God's plan for creation is foundational to helping your child understand the truths of God's authority over creation, how the world began, where sin came from, and the consequences of sin. The world attempts to undermine each of these concepts with false claims and philosophies, so it is important for your child to build a strong foundation on the truth found in God's Word.

In Unit 2, your child will recognize his or her own sinfulness and need for salvation. This unit introduces the Bible's storyline of God's work to provide salvation through His Son, Jesus. Your child will learn about Abraham, Jacob, and Joseph and the truths God revealed to them concerning His character and plan.

We need your help to accomplish these spiritual goals. In addition to hearing the Bible lesson each week, your child will participate in fun, interactive learning activities. Encourage your child to tell you what he or she learned each Sunday. Discuss the student book pages, help your child complete any unfinished activities, and assist your child in memorizing the verse for each week.

Your child will also bring home a Strong Kids take-home paper each week. Use the story, Bible story, activities, and Growing at Home section of the take-home paper to reinforce your child's Bible lesson. These resources help your child connect what is learned in church to life at home, motivating spiritual growth.

Weeks 1—6

God's Plan for Creation Begins

Lesson 1 will emphasize that God is holy. Students will learn the meaning of the word and God's response to sin in light of His holiness. The next four lessons will focus on the Genesis account of creation, God's special care in creating people, the sustaining power of God, and God's judgment on Adam and Eve's sin. The unit ends with the account of Noah and the Flood. These lessons will impress on students the seriousness of God's holiness and His wonderful provision of sustaining grace despite our sin.

Weeks 7—13

God's Plan for Salvation Begins

Students will learn how God worked through the lives of Abraham, Jacob, and Joseph to begin His plan for salvation. The Bible lessons will focus on God's presence, provision, and grace as He interacts with each person. Each account points forward to God's ultimate plan of salvation that would be fulfilled in Jesus Christ's sacrificial death for our sin.
