Bible Memory Changes Lives!

The Bible is the most powerful spiritual tool we have as believers because the Holy Spirit makes the Bible alive and active in our hearts and minds (Heb. 4:12). No other book can change our lives like the Bible can. Believers who regularly memorize Bible verses understand the Bible's power.

After we have memorized a Bible verse, we should think about it and consider how it applies to our lives. Thinking about the meaning and application of Bible verses is called Bible meditation (Ps. 1:2). The Holy Spirit assists us as we meditate on Bible verses. He helps us understand any promises in the verses, convicts us of any sins the verses point out, and encourages us to obey any commands the verses communicate.

The process of memorizing and meditating on Bible verses renews our minds over time. The verses transform our thinking so that we think like Christ. We become much more sensitive to sin so that we sin less and obey God more (Ps. 119:11).

When we think and live like Christ, we will know His joy, peace, and contentment. We will spend less time discouraged, fearful, and unhappy. Bible memorization is a privilege. Work on memorizing God's Word today!
